Terms of Reference

- 1. The Board is required to review its terms of reference each year.
- 2. The proposed terms of reference for the Faculty of Graduate Research are as follows:
 - 1. To regulate, subject to review by Senate, teaching and learning in the areas of academic responsibility assigned to the Faculty and to constitute Boards of Studies.
 - 2. To recommend to Senate persons for appointment as Examiners.
 - To report to Senate on Ordinances and the approval of Regulations dealing with courses of study for Degrees and other distinctions and on any questions relating to the work of the Faculty.
 - 4. To make recommendations to Senate for the award of Degrees (other than Honorary Degrees), Diplomas, Certificates, Fellowships, Studentships, Scholarships and Prizes within the Faculty.
 - 5. To consider any matters relating to the Faculty referred to or delegated to it by Senate and to express opinions on such references or such other matters as seem relevant to it.
 - 6. To maintain oversight of the University's Accreditation Procedures and to receive reports from the Dean and Colleges on proposals for new programmes and amendments to existing programmes.
 - 7. To ensure that the business of the Board is handled in such a way that it is consistent with the University's duty to promote equality and eliminate discrimination.
 - 8. To collaborate with, Quality Strategy Group, Colleges and academic support units in the development, implementation and review of the University's strategies for education.
 - 9. To consider reports of periodic subject reviews and annual monitoring and to report to Senate.
 - 10. To maintain oversight of the University's collaborative provision activities, receiving reports from Collaborative Provision Committee.

- 10.12. Three members from each College, to include the Associate Dean Research and Knowledge Transfer.
- 11.13. Two full-time students elected by the full-time students of the University, the election being conducted by the Students' Guild.
- 12.14. One representative from PCMD (non-voting).
- 43.15. Other members co-opted as appropriate.
- 3. The Board is invited to **RECOMMEND TO SENATE** approval of the above terms of reference.
