- **Room 0.31** – 32 seat PC cluster

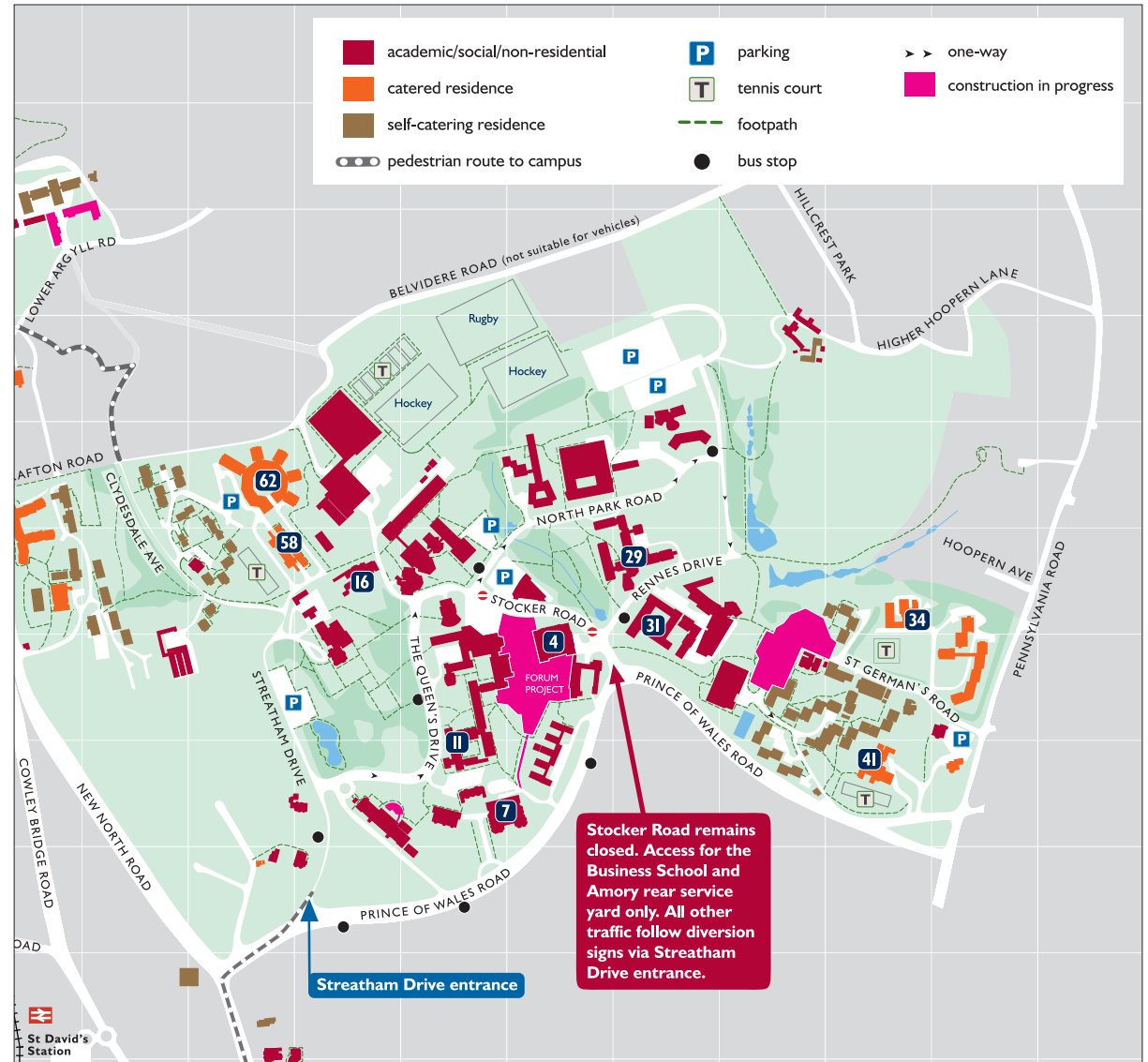

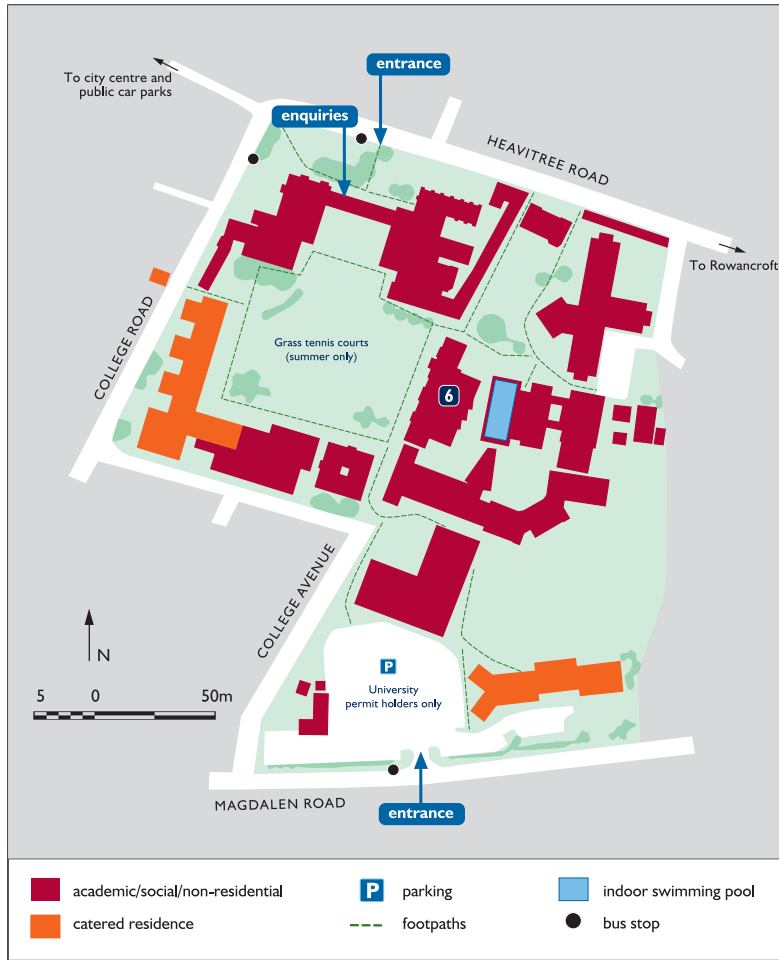
